

Local Law # ___ of 2011

A local law to amend Chapter 143 of the Code of the Village of Piermont, entitled "Parks", specifically section 143-6, entitled "Traffic", as pertains to the operation of motor vehicles in the Piermont Pier Park.

Section 143-6 (F) shall be amended to read as follows (*new text in italics*):

§ 143-6. Traffic.

No person shall operate any vehicle in a park unless specifically permitted by this chapter. With respect to the form Erie right-of-way park, no motor vehicles shall be permitted except in an emergency as defined by the Board of Trustees. Where vehicles are permitted, all persons shall operate their vehicles in accordance with applicable traffic laws, rules and regulations, and the following acts or omissions shall constitute a violation of this chapter:

F. Piermont Pier Park.

(1) No person shall operate a motor vehicle at any location within the Piermont Pier Park without first obtaining a Pier Permit from the Village Clerk's office, which permit shall issue upon the completion of the application form provided by the Village Clerk, and according to the fee schedule set forth in § [102-4F](#) of the Village Code.

1(a) Generally, Pier Permits shall be granted only to facilitate motor vehicle access to the Piermont Pier Park for the purpose of recreational fishing and crabbing. Additionally, Pier Permits shall be granted to facilitate access to the Piermont Pier Park by senior citizens and disabled persons (see § 102-4F of the Village Code).

(2) Exceptions: The following vehicles shall not require a permit as set forth in this paragraph: New York State D.E.C. vehicles, official vehicles of the Village of Piermont, vehicles with Disabled Access Permits issued by New York State D.E.C., and vehicles with valid New York State Handicap license plates.

This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
